

MusIQ Club Level 2: Theory Worksheet – Half Tones and Whole Tones

Half tones are the smallest interval on your keyboard. They go from one key to the very next key, whether it is black or white. For example: E to F is a Half Tone. So is G to G sharp.

Whole tones are made up of 2 Half Tones, and so they skip over one key.

For example, A to B is a whole tone. So is B to C sharp.
