Theory Worksheet: Terms Review

Each word in the left column is a term used in music to describe how the notes are to be played. **Tempo** terms have to do with the speed of the music, **Dynamic** terms describe how loud or soft the music is, and **Articulation** terms have to do with whether the notes are to be played bouncy or smooth.

Draw a line to connect each term to its meaning, and in the blank write a T for tempo, D for dynamics, or A for articulation.

___	Allegro	Soft
___	piano	Slowly
___	staccato	Moderately loud
___	mezzo piano	Moderately soft
___	legato	Short and detached; bouncy
___	crescendo	Loud
___	Adagio	Smooth and connected
___	mezzo forte	Gradually getting louder
