More Practice with Sharp Key Signatures

Use the keyboard shortcut for the circle of fifths to name the following key signatures. For the example question, you would choose the sharps shortcut and go up until you get to "1". The note you are on is G, so G Major is the key that has 1 sharp.

Use the keyboard shortcut for the circle of fifths AND the Order of Sharps to write the following key signatures. For the first question, you would choose the sharps shortcut and go up until you get to "A". The number you are on is "3", so A Major has 3 sharps. Use "Father Charles..." to help you remember the first 3 sharps. Write them on the blank, and then draw the key signature above.
